

How to Print or Save Your "Trainee Evaluation Done" Screen

The American Board of Pediatrics (ABP) strongly recommends that you **print** or **save** your "Trainee Evaluation Done" screen because once you submit your trainee evaluations in the <u>Program Portal</u>, you will not be able to return to see them.



Because we are dedicated to continuously improving your experience in your <u>Program Portal</u>, we are developing a print-friendly feature to allow you to print a summary of your evaluations submitted for your nongraduating and graduating trainees.

In the interim, however, you can **print** or **save** your "Trainee Evaluation Done" screen by taking a screenshot of the page using a snipping tool such as Snagit or Snip & Sketch or by using one of the following methods.

Using Keyboard Shortcuts to Open the Print Window

- ON A PC: Ctrl+P will open a new window for printing or saving. See the section below if you prefer to save the document.
- **ON A MAC: Command+P** will open a new window for printing or saving. See the section below if you prefer to save the document.

Printing or Saving

- TO PRINT: In the new window, choose your printer destination and tap Print.
- TO SAVE FOR LATER: In the new window, select "Save as PDF" as your print destination and tap Save.

Note that these instructions may vary based on the browser you are using.
