Clinical Privileges and Continuing Board Certification

Granting and delineating the scope of clinical privileges are institutional responsibilities, vested in the medical staff and the governing body of the healthcare organization.

The ABP supports consideration of a physician's education, training, practice experience, performance and other criteria, including Maintenance of Certification or Continuing Board Certification, in granting and delineating the physician's clinical privileges.

The ABP also believes that Maintenance of Certification or Continuing Board Certification should not be the sole determinant in granting and delineating the scope of a physician's clinical privileges.
