Credit for Previous General Pediatrics Residency Training After an Interruption

Residents who experience an interruption in general pediatrics training for greater than 24 continuous months and who wish to re-enter residency training in general pediatrics must petition the ABP to determine whether credit may be awarded for prior training. The request for credit must be submitted by the candidate or the residency program director before the candidate re-enters residency training in general pediatrics. This policy is in effect for those re-entering general pediatrics training July 1, 2010, or thereafter.
