## THE LATEST UPDATE

Starting in 2024, the American Board of Pediatrics (ABP) will bring the SITE exam to you! Instead of visiting a Prometric center, trainees will soon have the ability to take the exam online at your institution. The online exam will be proctored by their program director, coordinator, and other faculty members.

Following the successful pilot implementation of Internet-Based Testing (IBT) for the 2023 SITE across 16 institutions and four pediatric subspecialty areas, ABP has decided to transition to administering the SITE online. We received positive feedback from participants, and we are confident that IBT will benefit all trainees and fellowship programs across 15 pediatric subspecialty areas.
